Food safety versus Food defense vs. Food security

Food safety:

Food safety addresses the accidental contamination of food products by biological, chemical, or physical hazards. This unintentional contamination of food products can be reasonably anticipated based on the type of processing.

Food Defense: (FSMA)

"Food defense means the effort to protect food from intentional acts of adulteration where there is an intent to cause public health harm and economic disruption."

Food Security: (World Health Organization) "when all people at all times have access to sufficient, safe, nutritious food to maintain a healthy and active life".
